- *** Elimination Event

RSC Exceptions and Clarifications:

- 1) Scrapbooking is an ISC event offered only to females. Since this event is offered to both males and females in the RSC, male winners will not advance to ISC.
- 2) Badminton is a non-ISC event and is only offered at this SOTAM RSC. The availability of this event is subject to annual logistics and committee's decision.
- 3) Please refer to ISC guidelines (document attached). Guidelines for Badminton, Handwriting (9-12yrs), Bible Memory Character Trait (9-12yrs), and Spelling (9-12yrs) will be sent out to the schools soon.
- 4) Due to time constraints, students are only allowed to choose between the following events as these events will run concurrently.

Chess (203) or Chinese Chess (704) - restriction is applicable to both junior and senior participants

Basketball (427/720) or Badminton (723/731) - restriction is applicable to both male and female participants

- 5) i. Please ensure that your students and school meet the requirements for the number of elimination and non-elimination entries allowed per student and per school.
- ii. Every student must register for a minimum of 3 events in at least 3 Divisions out of 5.
- iii. No absentee entries will be accepted.
- iv. Number of entries per school (per Junior or Senior Convention)
 - (a) Events involving more than 4 students or group elimination events (eg: PACE Bowl, Basketball) 1 entry per school
 - (b) Other elimination events (Chess/ Checkers/ Chinese Chess/ Table Tennis/ Badminton) 3 entries per school
 - (c) In One Act Play and Bible Bowl, a school is allowed three entries
 - (d) All other events 6 entries per school

As we are running both the junior and senior Conventions in one, the number of events allowable are per Convention per school and not events from 2 Conventions combined together per school. For example:

- (a) a school may send 3 participants for Chess for the 9-12 years old and 13 years old categories respectively, so in total, 6 participants are representing the school in this event.
- (b) a school may send 6 participants for Spelling for the 9-12 years old and 13 years old categories respectively, so in total, 12 participants are representing the school in this event.
- v. Number of individual events RSC rules:

The maximum number of entries allowed per student is 12.

- (a) A contestant may enter any 8 performance events with the exceptions noted below.
- (b) A student may enter numerous non-performance events within the total combined events limit of 12.
- (c) A student may enter a maximum of 3 elimination events.
- (d) A student may enter a maximum of 4 athletic events. Students who participate in any athletic events must enter at least 2 non-athletic events.
- (e) A student may not participate in 2 identical events (eg. 2 male duets, or 2 one-act plays)

- 6) The RSC will be opened for registration on February 26, 2018. More information will follow in a separate email. The closing date for all registrations is May 7, 2018.
- 7) Please remember to read up on the requirements for culottes as no baggy pants are allowed for female participants. All female participants must wear culottes for sports competition and on Athletics Day. All culottes and sports pants must be below the knee. Refer to the attached document, "Culottes" for the ISC approved type and length of culottes for all Student Conventions.
- 8) The Bible Bowl (#217) books this year are II Kings, Hosea, Numbers, John, I Corinthians, & I Peter.
- 9) The Scripture passage for Group Bible Speaking (#629) is to be chosen from the following list:

12) Early Entry Submissions - Deadline is May 14, 2018

To help facilitate judging, the following entries must be sent to the SOTAM RSC committee by May 14, 2018. Any entries that arrive after will not be judged. Winners must be present at the SOTAM Regional Student Convention in Tawau from September 2-7, 2018 to receive their medals. Medals wil not be sent to the students. If a winner is not present, then his/ her name will be removed from the winners' list and the subsequent winners will move up. Please note that the following events count toward the total number of school and individual entries submitted/ entered. (Total combined number of performance and nonperformance events must not exceed 12. Only 6 entries in each event may be submitted from each school).

- (c) Short Story Writing (#222)
- (d) Website Design (#223)
- (e) PowerPoint Presentation Linear (#224)

All art, science, social studies, photography and needle/ thread entries are to be submitted on-site at the Convention. For platform and music performance events, scripts, outlines, music, judges' forms, and photos are to be presented to the judges at the time of performance by the constestants. Be sure to read each division's requirements before submitting forms. Points will be subtracted for not providing proper current Judges' Forms where required.

14) ICCE students who wish to obtain a credit from the Regional Student Convention may earn two types of credit - Single Item Entry and Attendance & Participation Entry. Please refer to the 2017 European Procedures Manual for more details. Please take note of the amount of time needed for application, and the minimum score to attain in order to qualify for the Student Convention credit. Any application for ICCE credit must be submitted four months before the RSC. (We will not accept any applications after April 1, 2018).

15) The ratio of sponsor to students this year is 1 sponsor to 10 students. Please do not exceed this limit as it will be difficult for sponsors to manage and look after the students. Sponsors may also apply as judges. Please refer to the document, "Judge's Application Form (CF120).". Please print it out, fill it in, and send it in together with your students' early submission entries (due May 14th) or CF Forms (due July 23rd).
